We provide each student with a book bag filled with food, which they pick up Friday afternoon and return on Monday morning. These book bags contain 2 breakfast meals, tuna, crackers, peanut butter, and soup, ready to heat meals, snacks and fruit. Often there is enough to feed several family members.

We are currently providing food for 18-20 students per week. The high school also has a great need, but at this point we are only providing for 5 families. There are many impoverished families within the Lower Cape May area. More than half the school population qualifies for free or reduced lunch.
